We are pleased to announce that the 2019 Shanghan Lun Lines Retreat North-America is finally ready for your registration! Please join us in the beautiful Canadian Rocky Mountains for 10 days of in-depth study of the original Shanghan Lun text, line by line, as well as a celebration of the Summer Solstice.

This retreat is geared towards all North-American Diplomates of Canonical Chinese Medicine®, but is also open for overseas Diplomates from Australia and Europe. Participants are encouraged to bring their family members for a beautiful and relaxing vacation for all.

The Shanghan Lun Lines Retreat caps your many years of study of the Shanghan Lun based on the Tian Family tradition. We will study each line of the text with a detailed commentary and discussion by your instructor Arnaud Versluys, PhD. The instruction is based on Dr. Versluys' almost two decades of research of the Shanghan Lun and will quote extensively from late lineage holder Zheng Guanglu's personal notes on the Shanghan Lun.

This is a rare opportunity that should not be missed, especially considering that this event only visits each continent every 6 years. In other words, the next Shanghan Lun Lines Retreat in North America will not be until 2025!

The seminar consists of 6 hours of seminars, for ten days straight, thus conferring 60 NCCAOM (pending), and California (pending).

The Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge is a resort situated within Jasper National Park. The lodge is built around Lac Beauvert, which is a 15-minute walk from the Jasper village center. The lodge has four different in-house restaurants, a lounge, spa and health club, hiking trails, a golf course, cabins, a complete conference center, and Jasper's own planetarium.

Jasper is a small town in the Canadian Rockies known for its dark night skies, canoeing, fishing, glacier-fed lakes, hiking, wildlife, ice fields, hot springs, and more. While situated in this remote setting we will be able to enjoy a full moon, which is scheduled to appear right near the summer solstice. We may also get a glimpse of the aurora borealis

Jasper is located approximately five hours from both the Calgary and the Edmonton international airports. There are a number of shuttle bus companies and rental car options that can be booked to transport registrants from the airports along beautifully scenic routes to the lodge.

The trip to Jasper is stunning! You will be travelling through the serene Alberta foothills to the gloriously rugged Rocky Mountains. Keep your eyes on the roadside, too, to catch a glimpse of bears, wolves, or elk in their natural environment.

## Rooms

ICEAM has a guaranteed lock on 10 double occupancy rooms and 2 single occupancy rooms. Please register early. Once these rooms are taken, more rooms are available but are not guaranteed, hence it is imperative you book as soon as possible.

Single occupancy rooms; \$285 USD per day, for 11 nights total; \$3135 USD

# Room sharing

Double occupancy rooms; (two queen beds) \$285USD per night \$142.5USD per person per night, 11 nights total; \$1567.50 USD per person

<u>1 Luxury cabin</u> is available during our dates:

3 bedrooms (2 with a King Bed, 1 with 2 Queen Beds)

This is a newly renovated cabin with large living room, kitchen, & washer/dryer. \$350 USD per room per night – this rate is discounted for us. With room sharing this cabin can provide space for 6 people each at \$170USD per night.

### Board:

We have arranged a food and beverage package for the group:

Breakfast, lunch, and two breaks for coffee, tea, and snacks, will be provided for each of the 10 days you are at the retreat. This food and beverage package will cost each registrant \$75.00 USD per day, for a total of \$750.00 USD.

Registrants will be responsible for their own dinner and drinks. There are four restaurants in the hotel as well a number of places to dine in the town of Jasper just a short walk away.

The **total estimated room and board cost** for 10 days and 11 nights (in shared-room accommodation, and the food and beverage package) is \$2317.50 USD.
